Japan Open 2010 Rounds 1 & 2 - Play 18 holes on EACH course – total 36 holes

- Competitors will enjoy the challenges of both Fujin and Raijin Courses
- Round 1 Staggered Shotgun Starts - Pool A & Pool B will start appx. 1 hour apart
- Both Rounds - Random Group Selection (Japan Traditional Style- This gives players the chance to play with more International players.) Please enjoy.
- Lunch will be provided. Please look for a lunch ticket in your Player's Package.
- After Round 1 - Players will be grouped by score within Pool.
- Round 2 – Staggered Shotgun Starts TBA
- Players will remain in original pool and be sorted by score after Round 2.

Jun. 11th (Fri.)

Japan Open 2010 Rounds 3 & 4 - Play 18 holes on EACH course – total 36 holes

- Round 3 format Staggered Shot Gun Starts. Pool A & Pool B start appx. 1 hour apart.

- After 3rd Round players shuffled according to SCORE within Pools.
- Round 4 – Staggered Shotgun Starts TBA

ARRIVING AT NARITA AIRPORT (JAPAN)

Japan Open staff will be waiting for competitors through the Arrival Lobby doors at both Terminals One and Two. They will guide competitors to the Official Hero shuttle bus. The bus will transport competitors from Narita International Airport to Nasu-Kogen (Pure Cottages). Please look for the Japan Open Staff wearing bright orange tournament shirts or jackets! The Shuttle Bus will have orange Hero Flags as well.
